The French authorities have announced that all businesses operating in France must select a registered Partner Dematerialization Platform (PDP) for electronic invoicing.



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France Compliance Webinar: 6 Highlights - Dec 2024

The two key points of the e-Invoicing and e-Reporting mandate in France

Electronic invoice transmission via a PDP for domestic B2B and B2G transactions, and the reporting of data for international B2B and B2C transactions to the tax authorities via a PDP or the PPF (as of October 15, 2024, the PPF will function solely as a platform for e-Reporting).

The model without the PPF

The government's free portal for the issuance and receipt of electronic invoices will no longer be available after the decision of October 15, 2024.

Registered PDPs are essential to ensure compliance in France.

Key steps of the mandate and the **ViDA context**

- 2024: Technical preparation.
- 2025: Pilot phase and testing.

Our first pilot, Air France, was signed in early October 2024.

• 2026 - 2027: Gradual obligation for the reception and issuance of electronic invoices for large companies, mid-size companies (ETIs), and SMEs, with an e-Reporting obligation for the issuer.

ViDA Context:

Adopted in November 2024, ViDA introduces the obligation for electronic invoicing across the European Union starting in July 2030.



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
